We are pleased to announce the third annual **Wine Country Miniature Donkey Classic**! This year's show will take place June 25th – 27th, 2010, in Santa Rosa, California. We were again fortunate to secure the beautiful facilities of the Sonoma County Fairgrounds located in the heart of California's Wine Country.

NEW ARENA

The 2010 WCMDC will be held in the **Lyttle Cow Palace**, a covered, open arena, located just steps away from the Chris Beck Arena we used in previous years. Adjacent to the Lyttle Cow Palace is the Jamison Ring which will serve as our vendor area.



Wooden box stalls are adjacent to the arena. One bag of shavings per stall, including tack stall, will be provided. Limited additional shavings will be available for purchase. Stalls will be available beginning Thursday, June 24th through Monday, June 28th.



Let's add some bling to the barn! We will have a stall decorating contest open to all exhibitors, with a prize for first prize.

NEW NMDA CLASSES

Three **NEW** NMDA classes will debut at this year's WCMDC! We are thrilled to announce that we are offering Hurry Scurry, Scramble, and Big T. The **Hurry Scurry** and **Scramble** are in-hand, timed events combining cones, barrels, and jumps (walk-over ground poles for donkeys under three years old). **Big T** offers an additional gaming class for those driving.

NEW AWARDS

We will again be offering sub-youth (ages 10 and under) classes, NMDA High Point awards for Open, Green and Youth (ages 11-17), NMDA Best of Breed and NMDA Best of Show.

In the spirit of competition, we will also be offering NMDA Non-Driving High Point and NMDA Non-Driving High Point Pre-Green Champion awards. This will give all of our long eared friends an opportunity to be a champion!



Donkeys must compete in their respective classes according to the current NMDA rulebook. A single champion and reserve champion award (NMDA Non-Driving High Point Champion and NMDA Non-Driving High Point Reserve Champion) will be offered to donkeys competing in Open and Green (three years old and over as of show date). Donkeys competing for the Non-Driving High Point can not be entered in any driving classes at the 2010 WCMDC; however previous entry/participation in driving classes at any NMDA-sanctioned show does NOT affect eligibility for this award.

A single champion and reserve champion award (NMDA Non-Driving High Point Champion Pre-Green and NMDA Non-Driving High Point Pre-Green Reserve Champion) will be offered to donkeys competing in Pre-Green and Foal Pre-Green classes (Pre-Green is 18 months to 36 months old; Foal Pre-Green is 6 months – 18 months old as of show date).

HIGH POINT DESIGNATION – New WCMDC Requirement

High Point designation must be selected on entry form. If high point is not designated on the entry form, that donkey will not be eligible for a high point award. No cross-entry allowed.

LATE ENTRY FEE

WCMDC is waiving the late entry fee of \$20 per donkey. WCMDC cannot guarantee that entries received after June 6th will be included in the final show program.

CHANGES TO ENTRIES

An exhibitor may modify their entries (add/remove donkey and/or class) until the start of Class 1 on Friday, June 25th. Modifications will not be allowed once Class 1 has started.

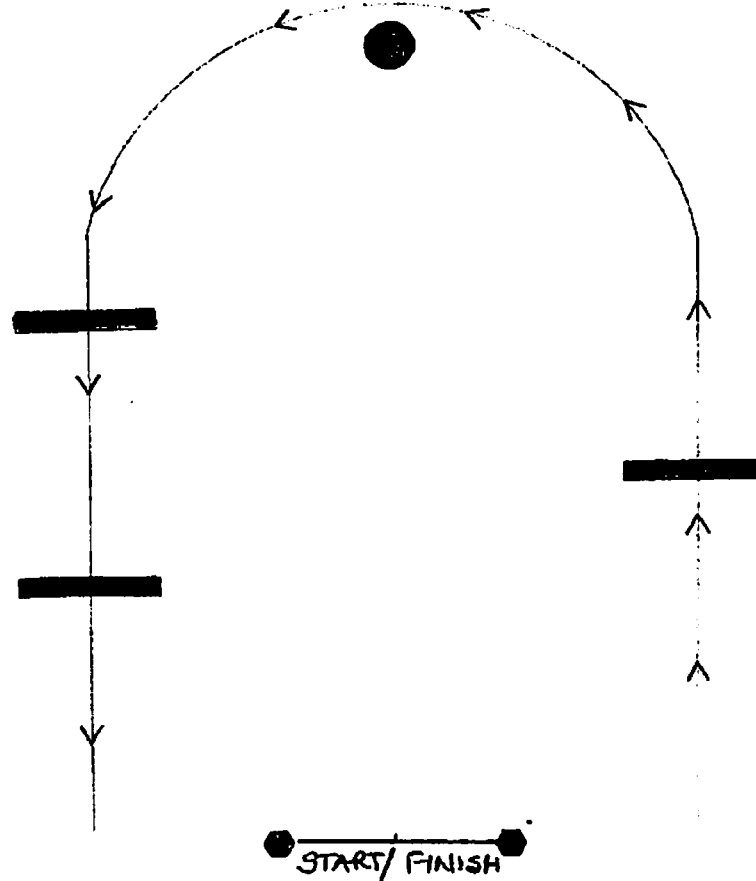
Hurry Scurry - In Hand

Timed event. For donkeys under 3 years old you must use ground poles only, no jumps. Any gait allowed.

Go across start/finish line, down right side, there will be 1 jump on right, go around the outside of the barrel and over the two jumps on the left and across the start/finish line.

In Hand Jumping rules apply, pg 20 #151

Scoring - Jumpers are to be scored on fastest time, with knock downs and refusals added to time- 5 seconds added for knockdowns and refusals with three refusals and off course result in elimination.



*Jumps are as follows- first jump 18", second jump 24" and third jump 20" Jumps sides no more than 5' tall.

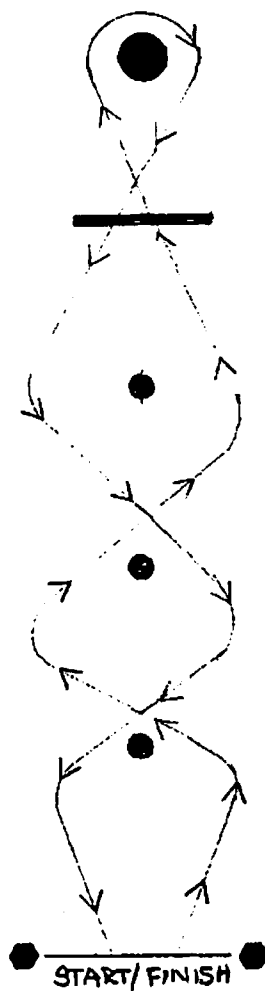
** This class will count towards NMDA points. However the distances are being run on a trial basis in 2010 and may be subject to change.

Scramble-In Hand

Timed event- For donkeys under 3 years old you must use ground poles only, no jumps. Any gait allowed.

Go across start/finish line down right or left pattern may be used, there will be three poles/cones to go around then a jump then a barrel, come back through jump, poles then start/finish line.

Scoring- Fastest time wins, knockdowns and any refusals (stop included) add 5 seconds for each with three refusals and off course, results in elimination.



*Jump 20" tall no more than 5 feet tall.

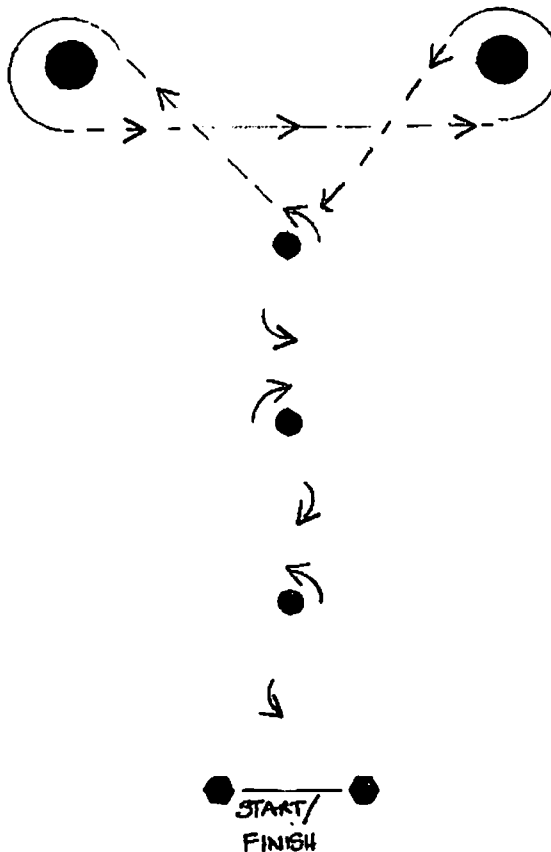
**This class will count towards NMDA points. However the distances are being run on a trial basis in 2010 and may be subject to change.

Big T - Driving

- A. This is a timed event, the fastest donkey and driver determined the winner. Knocking over a pole or barrel will constitute a five second penalty for each pole or barrel knocked over. Touching pole or barrel is permitted. Off course, elimination.
- B. Competitors will be disqualified for not following the pattern. Canter is NOT allowed in any driving classes for the safety of the donkey and competitor. You are allowed three strides to get the animal under control with a five second penalty. If you do not get the animal back into a walk or trot within three strides you are disqualified. If the animal breaks into a canter more than twice, this would also result in a disqualification.
- C. The course shall be measured with a tape following the diagram below.
- D. This class is run individually. Only one donkey and driver on the course at a time.

Go through the timing line, pass the first pole on either the left or the right, and pass the next two poles on alternate sides. If the third pole is passed on the right side, proceed to the barrel on your left, making a left turn and then a left turn around the other barrel. Then weave back through the three poles on opposite sides to pass through the timing line.

Note: Left or right hand pattern may be used. If the first pole is passed on the right side, the two barrels will both be left turns. If the first pole is passed on the left side, the two barrels will both be right turns.



* This class will count towards NMDA points. However, the distances between poles and barrels is being run on a trial basis in 2010, and may be subject to change.
